- 350 sites
- Two codebases and themes
- Two-week sprints
- ~1,000 editors

The odds are not in our favor





# Challenges

- Murphy's Law: 350 websites means there is much variation in content, user needs, and the odds that something will "break" with a deployment
- Maintaining and adding features to two codebases

# **Rocky sprint and deployment process**

Which sprint are we on? What's ready to deploy? Do site editors need to know and how would we tell them?

# Automations can help keep your sprints on the right track!

# When this... do that!

- Simple, at-a-glance overview
- Reminders, repeaters, snoozers
- Standardized tasks and lists
- "Kick-off automation" buttons
- Task assignments and pings
- Add-ons, power-ups, apps, etc.

# **GitHub Projects automations**

- Issue opened?Now it's a To Do!
- Pull Request opened?Now it's In Progress!
- Issue and PR closed?Now they are Done!



# Trello Butler automations

- Move a card to the QA column?
  Ping the testers!
- Time to push to dev or to test?
  Set a calendar card!
- Which cards in this deployment? Check for labels!

Oh, neat! There are some pretty cool GitHub + Trello integrations.

### **Continuous Integration and Deployment**

Bitbucket Pipelines, Circle.ci, GitHub Actions, GitLab CI, Jenkins, Travis.ci
